- c) The Club may exceptionally provide 100% funding but will normally expect the applicant raise an element of "matched funding" from elsewhere;
- d) If the applicant has yet to raise sufficient money to achieve the intended outcome the Club may issue a certificate in the form of a "pledge" committing the Club to making the agreed payment once the total amount has been raised. Such a pledge will normally be valid for twelve months;
- e) Grants will not be provided to support any national charity activities unless there is a direct, immediate and obvious benefit to the people of Kenilworth;
- f) Grants will not be provided to anyone raising funds to donate onwards to any local or national charity;
- g) Applicants may be asked to discuss their proposal with members of the Club's Community Services Committee if further clarification is needed;
- h) Wherever appropriate, Kenilworth Lions would like to publicise the outcome of any grant through local media to help facilitate its future fund-raising activities;
- i) If appropriate, successful applicants may be invited to a meeting of the Club to talk about their completed project;
- j) If necessary, please attach any additional information in support of your application.
